## **REGISTRATION & FEE INFORMATION FOR 2020 IB EXAMS**

IB Students and Parents:

Congratulations on your decision to participate in an International Baccalaureate course of study this year! The IB program offers rigorous college preparatory classes that culminate in exams that will be conducted between May 1-22, 2020.



Students need to register via the CHS website to take their IB exams. The deadline to register for the May 2020 exam session is October 18. If you are trying to decide if you want a particular IB exam or not, here are some additional thoughts to consider:

## Can you earn college credit for this course?

If a college you might attend is not listed here, search the college name + "IB credit" to quickly find out if they will give you credit for the IB course you are taking.

## Is it required for your Academic Honors Diploma?

You may need to take the IB exam if you are using your IB course to satisfy the requirements of your Academic Honors Diploma. See your counselor if you have any questions about your eligibility status, but here is the information from our CHS Program of Studies:

Students must complete one of the following additional requirements:

- A. Earn 4 credits in two or more Advanced Placement courses and complete the corresponding AP exams, or B. Earn 6 verifiable transcripted college credits in dual credit courses from the Indiana priority course list, or
- C. Earn 4 credits in International Baccalaureate courses and complete the corresponding IB exams
- D. Earn a combined score of 1250 or higher on the SAT (Math, Critical Reading and Writing) and a minimum score of 560 on the math and a 590 on the evidenced based reading and writing section.
- E. Earn a composite score of 26 or higher on the ACT and complete the written section.
- F. Earn two of the following:
  - A minimum of 3 verifiable transcripted college credits from the priority course list
  - Earn 2 credits in Advanced Placement courses and complete the corresponding AP exam(s)
  - Earn 2 credits in International Baccalaureate standard level courses and complete the corresponding IB exams.

## **REGISTER FOR YOUR IB EXAMS BEFORE FRIDAY, OCTOBER 18**

- 1. Please be careful to enter all information correctly. (Note: For your date of birth, be sure to input your BIRTH YEAR, not 2019.)
- 2. Bring a check made payable to "Carmel High School" to Mrs. Overbeck before

  November 1 at 3:30pm. Put the check in the blue drop box outside of her office
  (E135). On the memo of the check, please write "IB Exam" and your name. **Each test**is \$125. Note: Carmel Clay Schools will cover the testing fees of students who qualify
  for free and reduced lunch. These students still need to complete the online registration process.
