Welcome to the 2019-2020 school year! On behalf of the entire staff at Unionville High School, it is my great pleasure to officially welcome you back to Unionville High School for our 97th year. We would also like to extend a special greeting to our new students and families to the Unionville High School community.

In just a few short weeks, the school year will officially kick off on Monday, August 26, with a full day for all students. This school year, we are excited to roll out our new Lunch & Learn bell schedule (*Please see the attached document for the Bell Schedules*). There will no longer be a dedicated homeroom time prior to first period, instead, students will now report directly to their first period class.
