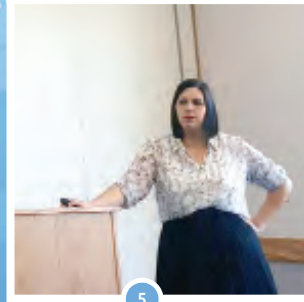


WHERE IN THE WORLD
