Please do not forget to have your student **dress appropriately on art days.**

I do NOT provide smocks for students, but you may send one in with your student. I am unable to store any smocks, so your student would be responsible for bringing it back and forth to school on art days.



Sketchbooks are needed for all students in grades 1st through 5th. The sketchbook can be store-bought drawing book or lined notebook, or better yet, scrap paper from around the house stapled together. **Sketchbooks must be NO LARGER than a standard sheet of paper- 8" by 10"...and should not be overly thick.**

Sketchbooks will be stored in the homerooms and we have to be understanding to the fact that space is limited.



Why am I not seeing my student's art work? We have a school art show at Cetronia in January. As a result I hold on to your student's work until that date so they can help me in selecting, mounting, and labeling their favorite piece for the show.
