CGIS Parent Reminders

- **CGIS is a secure campus that utilizes the LobbyGuard system for our student's safety.** When the school opens its doors at 7:00 am, all parents, guardians, and visitors must sign in on LobbyGuard located on the table in the entrance. Please make sure you bring your driver's license so you will be able to quickly sign into the system.
- **At the end of the school day if you are picking up your student for a doctor appointment, you need to be in the office signing them out before 2:25 pm.** This will ensure that your student is located and able to retrieve all their items prior to school ending at 2:40 pm.

- **We have Tennessee State mandated attendance guidelines for Maryville City Schools.** Please be sure to send in notes, medical documentation, or send an email to your child's homeroom teacher in order for absences to be excused! The guidelines established from the Tennessee Education Board state that a parent is only allowed 10 parent excuse notes for the entire school year. Each day a student is absent is equal to one parent note. Medical excuses can only be documented with a doctor or dental note with specific dates your student is not in school.

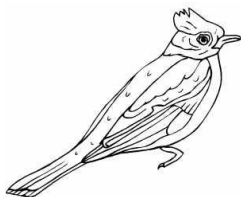
