Try ordering Scrip gift cards. The Scrip program allows participants to order gift cards to hundreds of your favorite retailers, including grocery stores, gas stations, restaurants, movie theaters, and MANY more.

A percentage of your purchase is refunded back to your student's choir account...it's that simple!!!  
Purchase either: Physical gift cards or ScripNow cards (e-cards that can be printed at home at anytime).

All orders are placed online using PrestoPay, an electronic debit funds transfer system.

Sign up now and you can start ordering ScripNow cards immediately! You will also be receiving an e-mail in August, directly through the Scrip system, inviting you to sign up. Our first order for physical gift cards will be in September. Be on the lookout in September for that email from Mrs. Nuteson, which will provide you with order deadline information.

### Enroll in Online Payments (PrestoPay™) to Conveniently Pay for Orders

ShopWithScrip gets even better when you enroll in Online Payments (PrestoPay). In addition to not having to drop off checks, you will also receive eGift cards and funds will be added to your ReloadNow cards instantly. Plus, you'll have access to ordering on-the-go with ShopWithScrip's mobile website, MyScripWallet™.

With Online Payments (PrestoPay), your order payment is transferred securely from your bank account to Great Lakes Scrip Center via electronic debit.

To enroll, log in to your ShopWithScrip account and follow these steps:

- Click on the Payment Types link under Family Functions on your Dashboard
- Follow the steps to enroll by either instantly linking your bank account or entering banking information manually
  - Manually entering your information will take 1-2 business days to process
