Dress Code <u>Non Negotiables</u>

- No short shorts, skirts, or dresses. All shorts must have a 4" inseam (length of your ID)
- No bare midriffs, backless shirts, dresses, pajamas, or sheer clothing
- All tank tops must have a strap wider than the short side of your ID card
- No flip flops, slides, or slippers (must have heel strap)
- No tears in shorts or pants higher than the length of a pair of shorts – the long side of your ID
- No facial piercings, nose piercings, large hoops, or spacers
- No artificial hair colors, extensions, weaves, etc.

 - Not styled in a manner that brings attention to student
















Bandanas

No Flips Flops, Slides, or Slippers








Dress Code

 - No facial piercings of any kind





What happens if I am out of dress code?

- All dress code infractions will be logged into our data base.
- Students will be given PE loaner clothes to change in to.
- Students will receive lunch detention and MAY lose merits.



HILLVIEW MIDDLE SCHOOL HOME OF THE HAWKS Scooters, Skateboards, and Bikes

- Scooter and Skateboards are NOT allowed. If found in bushes or anywhere else, <u>they will be confiscated</u>, which will require a parent or guardian to pick up.
- Bikes are allowed, but you must have a helmet. No helmet, bike stays at school.





HILLYIEW MIDDLE SCHOOL HOME OF THE HAWKS Some general reminders:

- Food is only allowed in the cafeteria or on the patio. Food is not allowed to be taken to the playground. Sodas are not allowed any time.
- No gum is allowed at anytime! We repeat ...
 - NO GUM IS ALLOWED AT ANYTIME.
- Students should not be in the hallways without a pass.
- No hats, hoods, or beanies are allowed to be worn indoors. Hats worn outside need to have the brim facing forward.
- Groups outside larger than 5 should separate or sit.
 - SPREAD OUT OR SIT DOWN NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Always show respect, both to the staff and to your peers.


