STUDENTS IN GRADE 11 are provided the opportunity to take the **PSAT/NMSQT at Greenwich High School on Wednesday, October 16, 2019**. This PSAT is the qualifying exam for the National Merit Scholarship Competition, as well as a practice test for the SAT used to meet graduation proficiencies and for the college admissions process.

We strongly encourage every junior to take the PSAT. **Juniors MUST REGISTER for the PSAT beginning TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 10th from 8:15 a.m. TO 3:30 p.m. in the GHS Main Office.**

The registration DEADLINE is Monday, September 23rd. Please register early. THERE WILL BE NO LATE REGISTRATIONS after the deadline.


The test fee is \$20.00. We can accept cash, or checks made payable to GHS in the amount of \$20.00. Juniors receiving free or reduced lunch at Greenwich High School are automatically eligible for fee waivers.

Students who require testing accommodations must identify this need when registering and must have been previously approved for accommodations by the College Board.

All students will be given a PSAT practice booklet when they register. Students can also practice through the College Board website's connection to Khan Academy, or by reviewing their PSAT results from 10th grade. Classes are located at Greenwich High School on the dates and times indicated on the ACE website in the Fall 2019 Catalog. STUDENTS IN GRADE 9 AND 10 will also take the Practice PSAT on Wednesday, October 16 at Greenwich High School. The test fees are paid by the district. Freshmen and Sophomores will be given practice booklets and preparation through their Seminar Skills classes.
