

Disciplinary Consequences

Examples of behavioral infractions and typical consequences follow. These examples are not intended to be exclusive or binding; student consequences for behavioral infractions are at the sole discretion of Porter-Gaud School.

| Behavioral Infraction | Potential Consequence |
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| Level 1 Non-malicious name calling or ridiculing; physical "horseplay" in the nature of pushing, hitting, tackling, throwing objects, tripping, etc. Littering, disrespecting Auxiliary Staff or leaving supervised areas without notice/permission. | Level 1 First documented strike and note e-mailed home in addition to Head of Middle School, Maureen Daily. |
| Level 2 Second offense of Level 1 behavior or extreme initial offense of Level 1 behavior. | Level 2 Second documented strike. Parents and Head of Middle School notified and potential parent meeting. |
| Level 3 Third offense of Level 1 behavior, Second Offense of Level 2 behavior, Fighting or action that causes physical harm to others or PG property. | Level 3 Third documented strike. One week suspension from Cyclone Club and Study Hall. Required meeting with parents, Head of Middle School and Auxiliary Director. |
| Level 4 Second offense of Level 3 behavior. Overt action of a premeditated intent to do physical harm to another either individually or part of a group ganging up Potential violation of the Harassment/Abuse Policy | Level 4 One month suspension from Cyclone Club and Study Hall. Required meeting with parents, Head of Middle School and Auxiliary Director to create a plan of action and expectations moving forward. |
