### Announcements:

- **BACK TO SCHOOL** – School starts Tuesday, August 20<sup>th</sup> at 8:30am and is an A/B Day. See the schedule above. Please note that Tuesdays are always an 8:30am start with class starting every other school day at 7:30am.
  - **OFF CAMPUS and IVC CLASSES:** Students having IVC or off campus classes should communicate with their teachers in these classes as they will not likely be able to attend on the first day due to the alternate schedule.
  - **DRESS CODE** – Please review the [school dress code policy](#) with your student and help them to meet these expectations.
  - **Dances - Effective for the 2019-2020 school year only current Clearfield High students will be allowed to attend Clearfield High dances.** Activities are an important part of fulfilling our school mission and vision to ensure ALL students learn at high levels and are prepared for post high school opportunities through a meaningful and personalized experience. In recent years we've had an increasing number of guests attend our dances. At Prom last spring we had over 200 non-Clearfield attendees. For every guest attending our dances, there is potentially a Clearfield Falcon that doesn't get asked and misses an opportunity to be connected to our school through an activity. In addition, there are significant logistical challenges, and safety issues that have arisen with the increasing number of guests at our dances. We've discussed these concerns with our student leaders and advisors who support this change. In addition to the traditional couple tickets that are sold for dances, single tickets will also be sold to encourage all students to participate in our dances. The dance times have also been adjusted for this year from 8pm-10pm with doors opening at 7:45pm.
  - **ID Badges and Lanyards** - - In our continuing efforts to ensure safety and security, all Clearfield High students will be required to wear their school ID and school issued lanyard together throughout the school day. A temporary ID will be issued the first day of school that will expire when official student ID's are distributed in early September. Attendance in each class will be recorded by scanning the student ID. Replacement lanyard/badges will be \$5.
  - **PICTURES** – Bell photography will be here taking student pictures during English classes on August 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>. Permanent school ID's will be distributed the next week.
  - **Electronic Devices** - In conjunction with our CHS Community Council, the Davis District School Board, and the Davis District Office, our electronic devices policy has been revised and is now posted on the school website under 'school information,' and 'student handbook/policies.'
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
