State of Kansas students must meet the following requirements to be guaranteed admission to any of the six Kansas State universities:

Complete the Qualified Admissions curriculum with at least a 2.0 grade point average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale AND

- Graduate from an accredited high school
- Achieve an ACT composite score of 21 or above (or SAT score of 980);
- OR Rank in the top one-third of your high school's graduating class.

If you have taken the ACT before and would like to improve your score, **RETAKE THE TEST!** Of the students who took the ACT more than once:

- 55% increased their Composite score
- 22% had no change in their Composite score
