


# Davis School District Behavior on the Bus



The safety and well-being of your student and others on the bus is critical. A team of individuals, including parents, bus



drivers, teachers, and school administrators, can support students in engaging in safe and positive behavior on the bus.

Parents play an important role in establishing behavior expectations, praising good behavior, and correcting behavior issues. Please review the information in this document with your child and coordinating with your child's principal on any concerns.

As a school, we want to make sure all students have a safe and positive experience on the bus. This helps set the student up for success throughout the school day and at home.



## Bus Rules

- 1- Listen to all adults on the bus
- 2- Stay in your seat
- 3- Keep hands & items to yourself
- 4- Use inside voice
- 5- Everything on the bus stays in the bus (nothing out windows)

In order to accomplish this, we want to make sure all students and their parents are aware of expectations for behavior and are aware of how students will be supported.

All Davis School District buses have a set of rules for expected behavior:

Students who follow these rules will help ensure the safety of themselves and others. Our drivers will make efforts to teach and remind students of these expectations.
