

JLCS - Required Reporting Dyslexia Info for 2018-2019

Act 1039 of 2017 Reporting by the School District (Ark. Code Ann. 6-41-606b)

During the 2018-2019 school year, Jacksonville Lighthouse Charter School used the evidenced-base program from the Orton-Gillingham Based System: Barton Reading & Spelling System in small group intervention to address the deficit areas of students identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.

Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention

During the 2018-2019 school year, 11 students attending Jacksonville Lighthouse Charter School received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

Total Number of Students Identified as Exhibiting the Characteristics of Dyslexia

During the 2018-2019 school year, 173 students attending Jacksonville Lighthouse Charter School were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.
