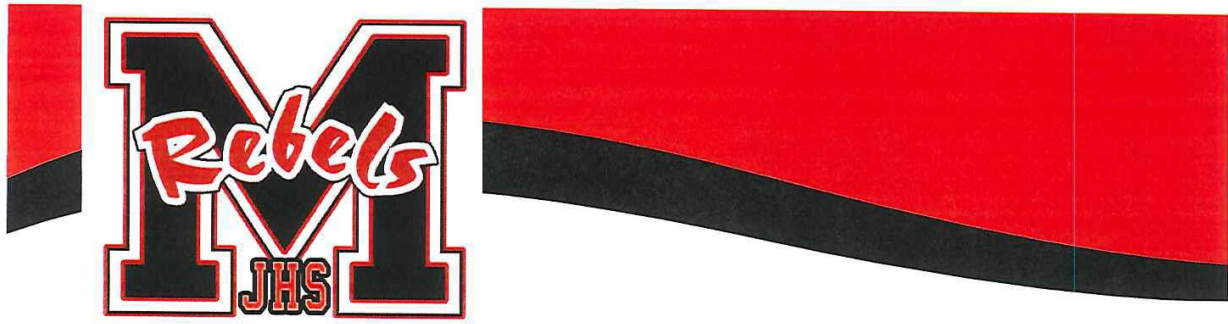
CGIS Breakfast Break
