

Extended Day Information Packet: 2019-2020

The Extended Day Program at SDS is the way in which we provide care of our SDS students after school hours and on some school holidays. This program has been designed to be an extension of the school day. The Extended Day teachers and staff actively promote the social, emotional, and physical development of each child. During the afternoon children will have the opportunity to engage in centers, take part in story time, play outside, and participate in many other diverse activities.

Extended Day provides care for preschool students from 12:15-6:00PM and for K-4th students from 2:30-6:00PM. Extended Day is also offered for 5th and 6th grade students from 3:30-6:00PM.

Students in grades K-4th enrolled in our Extended Day program will participate in our Homework Club Monday-Friday. Homework Club is an hour long. Our Extended Day Program strives to provide an age appropriate program with varied activities that build self-esteem through positive interactions and experiences.

Enrichment offerings provide an opportunity for our students to develop skills and interests in a variety of areas. Enrollment in after school enrichment classes are offered to all SDS students in grades 2K-4th grade. In the past we have had such offerings as karate, dance, gymnastics, golf, soccer, tennis, voice, strings, piano, and many more. Please refer to the descriptions, fees and registration process via our website for more details and information on each class. While enrichment offerings are for 2K-4th grade, students in the Discovery Classroom will have the option beginning in the spring to participate in soccer this school year. Please see sign-up for enrichment offerings for the 2019-20 school year.

Special Extended Days will be available on predetermined school holidays as determined by demand for an additional fee. A Special Extended Day calendar will be provided annually. On Special Extended Days, students will be engaged in a variety of developmentally appropriate hands-on activities including arts and crafts, science experiments, explorations, outdoor or gym time, games and more. In order to staff and plan accordingly, families must pre-register for these special days in advance in order for their children to attend. Registration notices will be sent via email prior to the scheduled Special Days. Extended Day information can also be found on our website.

The Spartanburg Day School Extended Day Program has incredible faculty and staff who are dedicated to providing the highest quality programs that promote each student's growth, happiness, and a foundation for a lifetime love of learning in a fun, caring and safe environment.

Extended Day for Preschool Students (Discovery, 3K, 4K)

Preschool offers a tuition bundle that includes Extended Day. If you choose this option, you will not be billed separately for Extended Day.

If you choose not to bundle, you will be billed a drop-in rate of **\$25 per day** (This is a daily charge and will not be prorated; Deadlines for drop-in sign-up will be communicated by Extended Day staff so they can adequately plan for staffing and programming.) The drop-in rate will include the hours: 12:15-6:00 p.m. Please remember that our Extended Day Program **ends at 6:00 p.m.** If you are late picking up your child, you will be charged a late fee of **\$25.00 per each fifteen minutes or portion of each fifteen minutes.**

Extended Day in preschool includes children eating lunch either brought from home or purchased from the school, rest time and extended playtime with activities and outdoor playground time. During Rest Time, each child will be provided with a personal mat to rest and relax on. Please bring a fitted crib sheet and a blanket for them.

Daily Activities

- 12:15-2:30 Lunch and rest/nap
- 2:30-3:00 Snack and Bathroom
- 3:00-6:00 Outdoor play, snack, toileting, rotation of: story, arts/crafts, music/movement, and Cove time

Lunch

Lunch time provides much more than nourishment for young children. Healthy habits are encouraged as children learn to wash their hands, eat with utensils and choose nutritious foods. Social interactions and fine motor skills are nurtured as children practice passing, pouring and socializing. Healthy foods provide children with the energy they need to play and learn. Your child's lunch should be balanced and

considerate of classroom identified allergies. The Day School partners with our food service, FLIK to provide a meal plan or an option for daily purchase of lunch. Learn more about lunch options:

If your child does not participate in the meal plan, we recommend sandwiches, yogurt, soup, fruit, crackers, cheese, etc. for lunch. We will provide water with lunch in the classroom. Caffeinated or carbonated beverages will not be served. Please try to avoid foods that contain excessive amounts of sugar, preservatives, artificial flavorings and caffeine. Lunches should be ready-to-serve (fruit peeled, soup in microwave-safe containers, etc.) and will be reheated if requested. We are unable to refrigerate lunch boxes. If you send items that require refrigeration, please use an ice pack. Children will be encouraged to eat a balanced meal that the parent has provided. However, if a child refuses certain foods, he/she will not be forced to finish the meal. Discovery parents, please review the daily report, which includes a section on food consumption.

Nap/Rest

Children in our preschool classes are required to have the opportunity to lie quietly on their mats for approximately 30 minutes. Quiet music is played, the lights are dimmed, and it is a period of relaxation for both nappers and non-nappers. Those children who do not fall asleep during the initial quiet time are given the opportunity to select quiet activities such as books or puzzles to occupy themselves on their mats while their classmates rest. Although we make every effort to meet each child's individual rest needs, it is difficult to guarantee a specific length of nap time or wake-up time as a child's rest needs vary with activity level and sleep patterns, etc.

Afternoon Snacks

An afternoon snack is provided by Extended Day on a daily basis. Items such as fresh fruit, graham crackers, pretzels, Cheerios, and vegetables may be served. Fresh fruit and/or vegetables will be served on a twice-weekly basis. Water is served with all snacks. The weekly snack menu is posted in the weekly Extended Day newsletter sent out to parents via email.

Afternoon Pick-Up

Children may be in on the playground, in the Cove, or in the classroom depending on the time you pick-up. Please use your key fob to enter the building and communicate any irregular pick-up instructions with the Director of Extended Day at extendedday@sdsgriffin.org.

Extended Day for Lower School Students (Kindergarten-4th Grade)

Homework Club

For our K – 4th grade students, this is a monitored Study Hall from 2:30-3:30 p.m.. If your child is present, you will be charged for Study Hall that day. Students who are not picked up from Study Hall will be added to our Extended Day program.

Homework is assigned on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday. On Wednesday and Friday's, the Homework Club time will be a time for hands-on, cross grade and enrichment activities, guest speakers, or other fun and engaging experiences. Depending on grade level, special activities may include technology activities, experiments, puppet shows/Readers' Theater, arts and crafts, and organized indoor and outdoor games/team building activities. The Extended Day staff will incorporate each child's age and developmental level, individual needs and interests when planning these activities.

If you choose not to bundle, you will be billed a drop-in rate of **\$20 per day** (This is a daily charge and will not be prorated; Deadlines for drop-in sign-up will be communicated by Extended Day staff so they can adequately plan for staffing and programming.) The drop-in rate will include the hours: 2:30-6:00 p.m. Please remember that our Extended Day Program **ends at 6:00 p.m.** If you are late picking up your child, you will be charged a late fee of **\$25.00 per each fifteen minutes or portion of each fifteen minutes.**

Extended Day Activities

For our 2K – 6th grade students, this is a monitored playtime with activities and outdoor playground time from 3:30-6.

Afternoon Snacks

Fresh fruit and/or vegetables will be served on a twice-weekly basis. Water is served with all snacks. Billing

All billing occurs at the end of each month. Please remember that our Extended Day Program **ends at 6:00 p.m.** If you are late picking up your child, you will be charged a late fee of **\$25.00 per each fifteen minutes or portion of each fifteen minutes.**

Special Extended Day Offerings

Special Days are offered by the Extended Day Program as a service to parents and are available for students in preschool-6th on selected days when school is not in session. While early dismissal days are included in the preschool bundling Extended Day fee, full special extended days are not. The fees are listed below. Sometimes these days fall on faculty/staff professional development days while other days may fall on some holidays in which the school will be closed.

Students will be engaged in a variety of developmentally appropriate hands-on activities including arts and crafts, science experiments, explorations, outdoor or gym time, games and more.

In order to staff and plan accordingly, **families must pre-register for these special days 1 week in advance in order for their child(ren) to attend. Space is limited, so please register early.**

Students will need to bring their lunches and snacks if they are attending during lunchtime, as the Dining Commons will not be open on these special days.
