

Cook Elementary Dress Code

Cook Elementary follows the dress code guidelines of the Davis School District. Please help your child by seeing that their clothing meets these standards. Anything that is disruptive to the normal operation of school or any dress or grooming that may be considered extreme is not permitted. Students whose clothing does not adhere to school/district standards will need to call their parents to have appropriate clothing brought to the school.

- ❖ All blouses, shirts, and tops must have sleeves. Clothing that exposes bare midriffs, buttocks, or undergarments, or clothing that is low cut and overly revealing is not allowed.
- ❖ Clothing containing obscene or suggestive words or pictures, including references to tobacco, drugs, or alcohol may not be worn.
- ❖ Clothing attachments which could be considered as weapons, i.e., spikes, chains, etc. will not be allowed.
- ❖ Skirts, dresses, shorts must be mid-thigh.
- ❖ Wear hair styles/colors that do not bring undue attention to the student or that may interfere or cause disruption to the educational process.
- ❖ Hats, bandanas, or other headgear may not be worn inside the building unless during Spirit Wear designated times as noted by the school administration.
- ❖ Appropriate shoes should be worn when participating in physical education activities and at recess.

We also ask that parents visiting our school adhere to these same standards so as not to disrupt learning.
