I promise to respect the facilities, abide by quiet hours as dictated by the facility management, and to pay for any repairs necessitated by damage I may cause. I understand that any damages/vandalism/negligence to hotel property, the tour bus, or any other property I come in contact with during the course of the trip, will be paid for by myself or my parents before the return flight home.		
I agree to be in my assigned room and to stay in my assigned room by the curfew. Curfew will be at 10:30 p.m. unless otherwise specified by the chaperones. I understand that leaving my room or visiting rooms of other students after the set curfew is prohibited.		
I understand I am not allowed to visit students of the opposite sex in their hotel rooms without the consent and supervision of the chaperones. Student displays of affection are not allowed.
