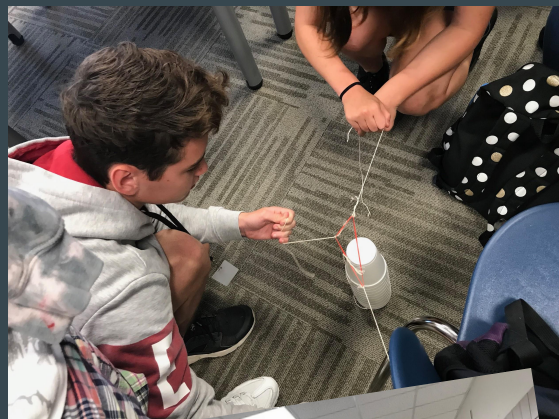

Must Pass all three Sections by sophomore year

Reading: Score must be a 351

Writing: Score must be a 5 on the essay
OR 340 on the multiple choice WITH a 4
on the essay

Credits and GPA

- ★ Your GPA (grade point average) starts now! Do well in your classes and your GPA will increase. DO NOT WAIT TO BEGIN FOCUSING ON YOUR GPA!
- ★ Honors, Advanced Placement and Dual Credit classes are not eligible for credit or cycle recovery.
- ★ EOC Tests: Algebra 1, Biology, English 1, English 2, and US History all must be passed for graduation
- ★ To be promoted to the next grade level you must have earned the minimum amount of credits:
 - 10th grade: 6 credits
 - 11th grade: 12 credits
 - 12th grade: 18 credits
 - Graduation: 26 credits

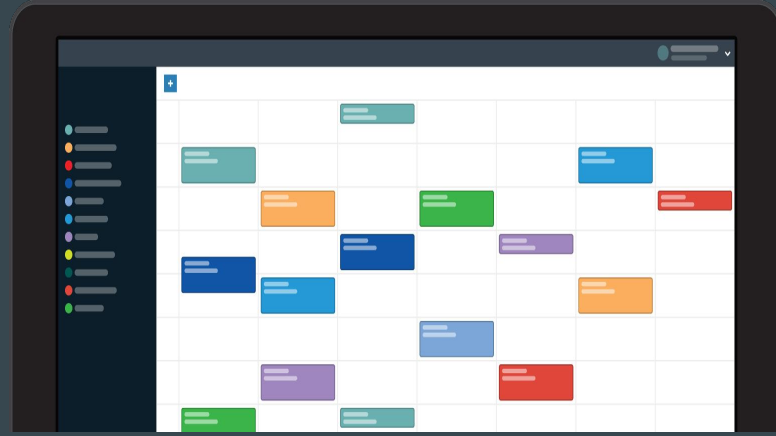

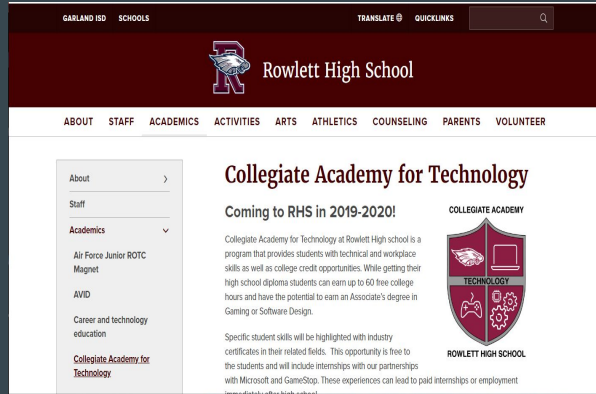
