
What Does It Mean For Me?

Get Started

Students run businesses, design, repair, build, market, and are fully engaged in practical learning.

Now's the time to explore your options.

Take advantage of our events on campus throughout the year. Meet instructors, tour labs, and see what your education could look like.

Then, during your sophomore year, submit your application. Total credits toward graduation, GPA, and attendance are all considered when reviewing applications and accepting students.
