The following procedures may be helpful in signing your children up to receive a lunch:

- Menus will be posted on the district web site at www.troy.k12.mi.us
 - Copies of the menu will also be available in the ECC Office.
 - The August/September Menu is also attached.
- Funds can be deposited on your child's account via "My School Bucks" - **myschoolbucks.com**.
 - Directions are also on the web site, but if you have any questions, please feel free to call our office.
 - Once funds are on your child's account, we will only charge a meal when you participate in ordering a meal.
 - Please know, any funds on your child's account will remain until you either request a refund, or your child graduates.
 - At any time, you can go online to view your child's account balance.
- Meals will be served to the children in the classroom by their teacher.
 - Fresh Fruit and a chilled milk will be included in every lunch.
 - Each day there will be three choices on the menu.
 - Each menu will consist of five components: a protein, fruit, vegetable, grain and a milk.
 - Orders will be taken by the classroom teacher in the morning and sent to the kitchen for preparation.
 - Once the meals have been delivered and we receive a final check-off list from the classroom teacher that your child has received their meal, we will then deduct the funds for that meal from your account.
