

A few clinic reminders regarding MISD policies for the upcoming school year:

1. Texas law requires up to date immunizations in order to register/attend a Texas school. You will be notified if your child is in need of any immunizations.
2. Prescription medications require a physician's signature on an MISD form in order for medication to be administered during school hours. Over the counter medications require a parent signature only. Please bring all medications to the clinic as students are not allowed to carry medications on campus, unless authorized by a physician.
3. MISD illness policy states students with 100.0 degree temp will be sent home from school and can return when student is fever x 24 hours (without any fever reducing medications) or as directed by physician. Parents will also be notified if any student has symptoms of vomiting, diarrhea, rash of unknown origin, drainage from eyes or any suspected communicable illness. This is for your child's protection as well as the protection of others.
4. MISD students in 5th grade will be screened for vision, hearing, scoliosis and acanthosis nigricans - which is a disorder that indicates high insulin levels in the body. Screenings are a state mandate. New to district students in 6th grade will also be screened.
5. Please notify the clinic as soon as possible if your child has any health condition that arises during the school year.
