Consideration to Approve Minutes:

The council will discuss options for fundraising to replace technology throughout the school. Possibilities include a Walk-a-Thon, company sponsors, or Wasatch Savings books. The council would like a list of specific items that need replacing to use for advertising to companies what their money would be going towards. In addition, the Council would like to review the School Improvement Plan from the previous planning year to familiarize all current and new members with our role as a Council is writing goals and allocating Trust Lands funds to benefit the students toward meeting school goals.
