



## Immunization Requirements

### Kindergarten Entry

*To attend kindergarten, a student must have written proof of receiving the following immunizations:*

- 5 DTaP/DT\* (4 doses of DTaP, if 4<sup>th</sup> dose given on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
- 4 Polio\* (3 doses, if 3<sup>rd</sup> dose was given on/after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
- 2 measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 2 Varicella (chickenpox)
- 2 Hepatitis A

*\*The final dose of DTaP/DT and Polio must be given after the age of 4 years AND a minimum interval of 6 month following the previous dose.*

### **Starting July 1, 2018 (Utah House Bill 308)**

Proof of immunity to disease(s), including chickenpox, can be accepted in place of vaccination only if a document from a health care provider states the student previously contracted the disease. Present health care provider documentation to the school office.

Parent/guardians who have students/children claiming exemption for required immunizations, must provide a **new exemption form when entering kindergarten**.
