A Program for Parents of children ages 2-8

Parenting can be a difficult experience for both parents and children. For children this is a major transition when they are moving from being dependent to exploring the world around them. It is a time when they test the limits of their environment, finding out what will or will not be tolerated. Learn how to guide your children as they go through this stage of transition.

Parents will learn how to:

- ◆ Strengthen children's social and emotional regulation skills.
- ◆ Implement positive discipline by establishing clear rules, routines, and effective limit setting.
- ◆ Utilize strategies that effectively handle misbehavior.
- ◆ Give effective praise and use age appropriate incentives.
- ◆ Teach children to problem solve
- ◆ Use play to strengthen their relationship with their child
