Visiting Sage Ridge School

The Shadow visit is an opportunity for us to observe your child interacting with peers and teachers; every bit as important, spending time here gives your child a chance to learn about our curriculum, programs, and general atmosphere.

We are all very excited to meet your child on one of our Student Shadow Days. To help ensure the day goes smoothly for everyone, here are steps we urge you to follow:

- Before shadow day, please talk to your child about the fact that s/he will be sitting in our classes. Your child is expected to participate and engage in class as fully as possible.
- Arrival and pick-up times:
 - Students should be dropped off at 8 a.m. and picked up at 3:15 p.m.
 - Please be prompt for pick-up on shadowing day. School is released at 3:15pm.
- When you arrive, please walk your child to the front office where you will be asked to fill out a contact information form.
- Your child should be dressed comfortably in modest clothes. No open toed shoes or sleeveless shirts allowed.
- Your child should come to Sage Ridge School with water and a snack. Your child should also have a book, notebook, and writing utensil.
- Your middle school child will most likely participate in Physical Education, so please also send seasonally appropriate PE clothes and athletic shoes.
- Lastly, visitors will spend time in their current grade or the grade for which they are applying, depending on which you think would be the best experience for your child.
