### **REQUIREMENTS**

We are seeking to appoint a talented and highly motivated teacher of English to teach from January 2020. The successful applicant will be enthusiastic, innovative and a team player with the ability to relate to students as individuals, in order to fulfil every student's learning potential in an international environment. A willingness to contribute to the curricular and extra-curricular development of the department is essential: the successful candidate will demonstrate their eagerness to promote the subject within the school through their contribution to extra-curricular activities and annual events such as Book Week, the Shakespeare Festival and regular theatre productions.

Furthermore, we expect our teachers to fully commit to the holistic ethos of the school and to contribute toward the development of our whole school aims; Thinking Skills, Language, Active Engagement, Leadership, Participation and Integration.

### **SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES**

The successful applicant will join English Faculty which comprises of 16 staff teaching within or across the English and Media Studies Departments. We are a large, well-resourced and successful faculty staffed by a friendly, supportive team. Teachers generally enjoy their own teaching areas in large, well-resourced classrooms and the Media facilities offer a range of technological options.

In line with whole school policy, the English Faculty follows the English National Curriculum but from an international perspective. All teachers in the faculty have access to support and training regarding EAL students and second-language classes are taught by specialists from the EAL Faculty.

In English lessons, Middle Years students are taught in mixed ability classes with support from specialist EAL/SEN staff as required. In the Upper School, Edexcel IGCSE courses are offered in English Language in addition to English Literature. Our students have achieved near a 100% A\*-C pass rate for the past three years, with at least 60% achieving an A or A\* or the equivalent 7-9 grade in both courses. The Sixth Form offers courses in AQA English Literature, CIE AS English Language, IB Literature and Language and Literature and IELTS for second language students.

Applications are invited from experienced and enthusiastic teachers of English who can deliver the whole curriculum range.

### **WIDER RESPONSIBILITIES**
