

## AIR FORCE JUNIOR ROTC (OK-942) GRADING PLAN AY 2020

Grading policy is based on the traditional format as a percentage of total points earned:

<u>Percent Score</u>	<u>Grade</u>
90 – 100%	A
80 – 89.9%	B
70 – 79.9%	C
60 – 69.9%	D
0 – 59.9%	F

A detailed grade point description is provided below. Grading elements are either a single event such as a report, or are comprised of multiple grading events such as quizzes and uniform inspections. Multiple grading events will total the identified point value, i.e. four 25 point quizzes will total 100 points when determining a final grade. For ease of identification, multiple grading events are annotated with an (\*).

**Academics:** About 75% of the JROTC grade will be derived from the Aerospace Science (AS), Leadership Education (LE) and Physical Training/Wellness curriculum (PT/W). The grading weight for these subject areas is 40%, 40% and 20% respectively, per USAF JROTC curriculum directive. A total of 2000 academic points can be earned for this school year.

**Participation:** About 25% of the JROTC grade will be derived from seven mandatory events, weekly classroom and physical training opportunities. Although not graded, participation in field trips is highly encouraged. JROTC field trips are described as Curriculum in Action (CIA) events. A total of 800 participation points can be earned for school year 2018/19.

**Extra Credit:** All cadets are offered the opportunity to obtain extra credit. Extra credit opportunities will be afforded based on events, JROTC cadet command needs, JROTC program needs and individual student coordination with instructors. A total of 200 extra credit points can be earned for school year 2019/20.
