

## OUT-OF-STATE SCHOLARSHIPS

The following premier scholarships are available for out-of-state students who complete the general scholarship application ([k-state.edu/apply](http://k-state.edu/apply)) in its entirety, and submit ACT/SAT scores and the \$40 application fee before the **December 1** priority date. In addition to individual GPA requirements listed below, these awards are eligible for renewal by maintaining full-time enrollment (a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester (fall/spring)) and maintaining continuous enrollment at K-State for the duration of the scholarship.

**Purple and White** **\$48,000 renewable four-year scholarship.** Awarded to out-of-state graduating seniors with a minimum 3.5 high school GPA and 24 ACT OR 1160 SAT. Eligible students receive **\$12,000 per year**. Renewable for up to three additional years (four years, eight semesters total) with a 3.0 K-State GPA.

**Denison** **\$32,000 renewable four-year scholarship.** Awarded to out-of-state graduating seniors in one of the following two achievement brackets: (1) minimum 3.4 high school GPA and minimum 24 ACT OR 1160 SAT, OR (2) minimum 3.5 high school GPA and 20-23 ACT OR 1020-1150 SAT. Eligible students receive **\$8,000 per year**. Renewable for up to three additional years (four years, eight semesters total) with a 3.0 GPA at K-State.

**Inspiration** **\$24,000 renewable four-year scholarship.** Awarded to out-of-state graduating seniors in one of the following two achievement brackets: (1) 3.2-3.49 high school GPA and 22-23 ACT OR 1100-1150 SAT, OR (2) 3.2-3.39 high school GPA with a minimum 24 ACT OR 1160 SAT. Eligible students receive **\$6,000 per year**. Renewable for up to three additional years (four years, eight semesters total) with a 3.0 GPA at K-State.

**Recognition** **\$16,000 renewable four-year scholarship.** Awarded to out-of-state graduating seniors in one of the following two achievement brackets: (1) 3.1-3.49 high school GPA and 20-21 ACT OR 1020-1090 SAT, OR (2) minimum 3.1 high school GPA with a minimum 22 ACT OR 1100 SAT. Eligible students receive **\$4,000 per year**. Renewable for up to three additional years (four years, eight semesters total) with a 3.0 GPA at K-State.

- SEPT. 15** ● Residence hall interest form opens. You must be admitted to K-State in order to complete the residence hall interest form.

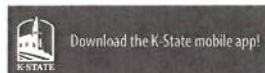

### Admission criteria

To be considered for qualified admissions you must:

1. Complete the Kansas pre-college curriculum with a 2.0 GPA (Kansas residents) or a 2.5 GPA (non-residents); **AND**
2. Achieve a 21 or higher composite score on the ACT assessment or 1060 or higher on the SAT I, CR + M **OR** rank in the top third of your graduating class; **AND**
3. Have a 2.0 GPA or higher on any attempted college credit work.

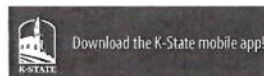
