NEW THIS YEAR

- **Large Incoming Freshman Class** - Mizzou is excited to welcome over **5,500 freshman students** to campus this fall. This class will boast an average ACT of a 26.
- **Scholarship Deadline Change** – Our MU Annual Scholarship Application is now due **Dec. 1**. Students are encouraged to apply for admission no later than Nov. 15 of their senior year to ensure maximum scholarship eligibility.
- **Housing Date Change** – Mizzou’s Housing Preference Form and Housing & Dining Contract open Dec. 1. These forms now should be submitted by **Feb. 1** to be included in the first round of housing assignments.

AND DON'T FORGET ABOUT THESE UPDATES FROM LAST YEAR

- **Automatic Scholarship Enhancements** – We have new and improved scholarships for your high school seniors. Changes include increased amounts, **eliminating the class rank and core GPA requirements** for automatic scholarships, and enhanced scholarships now starting at a 25 ACT.



- **NEW Honors College Process** – The Honors College is continuing their firm deadline of **March 1**. Applicants are required to submit a résumé and essay. In order to apply for competitive scholarships and research and artistry programs, students must be admitted to Mizzou and the Honors College by Dec. 1.
