Process to become an approved volunteer in the school:

After completing the online application, you will go to the Regional Office of Education located at 324 Main St., Room 401, Peoria, to be fingerprinted. Phone is 309-672-6906.

Fingerprinting days and times are Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.

This process is for any person planning to volunteer in the classroom, on a field trip, help as a copy parent, library parent, help with more than one class party, junior achievement, etc. This is also for any student teachers wanting to observe in a classroom.

Once done, please bring a copy of your certificate verification to the school office. We will generate a volunteer tag and give that to each approved volunteer when they come to the building to help.

One more level of security is scanning driver's licenses into our raptor security system. Any person entering the building past the school office will be asked to provide a valid driver's license for this process.
