Team Thunderbird places an emphasis on maintaining high standards in the quality of your education. We have several tools in place to help you stay informed about progress.

- We require that each child use the school provided agenda to record their homework. This agenda is expected to be brought to all classes and home every evening. Please ask to see your child's agenda in order to stay informed on daily homework assignments. Also, students may access homework and many assignments using Powerschool Learning, an online learning platform used to enhance student learning.
- 2. After-school academic support sessions are available for students to receive extra help from teachers most Mondays and Thursdays. These sessions allow for more individualized attention and should be seen as a tool, not as a punishment. Please encourage your child to attend these sessions and to come prepared with appropriate tools and specific questions if they need extra help in any subject. Students should make an appointment with a teacher, as all students *must* be with a teacher during this time.
- 3. Grades will be posted on Powerschool. Please check this resource in moderation. While it is school policy to update assignments every two weeks, longer assignments may require longer grading time. *Tip: Click on blue links to find out more about assignments and/or grade.*

As well as academics at Northwestern Middle School, there are a wide variety of extracurricular opportunities. For the sports enthusiast there are many teams including soccer, baseball, softball, cheer, field hockey, basketball, etc. For the student who likes to be involved there are clubs such as student council, drama club, civil rights stories, etc. Students are encouraged to develop their interest outside of academics. It is a chance to make new friends and get involved in the middle school experience.

Required School Supplies for the Core Academic Classes:

- 8 one subject composition books (4 in English, 1 in science, 3 reading)
- calculator (See math teacher for calculator most appropriate for course. A TI-84 PLUS or TI-84CE graphing calculator is optional in grade 7, but will be required in 8th grade.)
- blue or black pens/pencils/colored pencils/highlighter/erasers
- earbuds to allow student to listen during multimedia learning opportunities
- \$5 deposit for a PE Lock

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Dear Parents and Student,

We are excited to announce a unique educational program to **Riverfront Recapture** along the Connecticut River in East Hartford.
