

Dear Class of 2020:

You are down to your final year as a GHS Mustang! We challenge you all to meet/exceed all graduation requirements so that every member of the CLASS of 2020 will be able to celebrate together on graduation day in June! **Character Counts!** 

- 1. All graduation requirements including <u>80 Community Service Hours (or 10 hours per semester)</u> must be completed before you can participate in graduation practice. Community service hours must be completed **by May 1, 2020.** For questions please see Mrs. Mantani in Student Services.
- 2. Any senior with 2 or more N's for citizenship at 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter is <u>NOT</u> eligible to participate in end of the year senior activities including the graduation ceremony.
  - To appeal ineligibility seniors must have 0 N's at 4<sup>th</sup> quarter progress report (April 24, 2020), attend mandatory Saturday School (for N's received for attendance) and petition in writing to administration.
- 3. All seniors must attend a mandatory meeting, including mid-year grads and Independent Studies students during the graduation practice.
- 4. Seniors who are on the forty-five (45) day no activity list will not be able to participate in Prom or Magic Mountain, but could appeal to administration to participate in the graduation ceremony providing they meet all other eligibility requirements.

We expect all seniors to follow these rules to ensure that we will have a great ceremony, Character Counts!:

- 1. All seniors participating in the graduation ceremony must attend **ALL MANDATORY** practices unless the absence receives <u>prior</u> approval by administration. Non-participation in mandatory practice will exclude you from the graduation ceremony.
- 2. Seniors who choose to "ditch" or cut classes prior to the end of school will be in jeopardy of not participating in senior activities including the graduation ceremony.
- All school rules apply throughout graduation practice and senior activities. Seniors who violate school rules may be in jeopardy of not participating in the graduation ceremony. (Diplomas for those who are removed from the ceremony will be available in the main office the week of June 8<sup>th</sup> following a parent conference with an administrator).
- 4. All seniors will be dressed appropriately for graduation, which is business and/or dress attire.
- 5. All debts must be paid by **Friday**, **May 22**, **2020** or students will not receive their cap and gown to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- 6. All teacher detentions and Saturday schools must be cleared by May 29, 2020.
- **7.** Graduation tickets will be distributed to students during graduation practice. Each senior will be allotted 5 complimentary tickets to the Ceremony.

Students may purchase up to seven (7) additional tickets beginning Monday, May 1<sup>st</sup>. The cost of additional tickets will be announced before tickets go on sale.
