Great news! Wiseburn Unified was recognized by niche.com as the safest school district in California! In order to continue to enhance our safety, we have modified our volunteer procedures. All volunteers and visitors will have to do the following:

1. Attend Parent Volunteer Training:
  - a. Friday, September 6th at 9:00 a.m.
  - b. Thursday, September 12th at 9:00 a.m.
  - c. Monday, September 30th at 6:00 p.m.
2. Submit proof of a clear TB test within 3 years. Parents volunteering once do not require a TB test.
3. Complete online pesticide training. Please bring a copy of your certificate of completion to the front office. Click [here](#) to access the pesticide training information. Parents volunteering once do not need to complete the online pesticide training.
4. Check in using our Raptor system. Please read below about the Raptor system.

We have a brand new system for logging visitors into the office. This state-of-the-art system, called Raptor, scans a valid government-issued ID and screens visitors. Once you are cleared, you will receive a sticker ID badge that you must wear while on campus. Your information will be saved in our system for future visits. You will only need to sign in through the system to receive a badge each time you visit the Anza campus.
