

SAT PREPARATION PROGRAM FOR ST. MARK'S STUDENTS PREPARING FOR THE DECEMBER 7, 2019 EXAM

Standardized testing in the 2019-20 school year

Academic Approach is offering a standardized test preparation course for St. Mark's students who have targeted the December 7th, 2019 SAT exam date (registration deadline is November 8, 2019). This course is best suited for students who are interested in an efficient preparation course reviewing key skills in reading, writing, and math, and their applications on the SAT. The 24 hours of instruction introduce reading annotation, math problem-solving, grammar and rhetorical skills with an emphasis on their application on the rigorous SAT.
