

- The Board of Education approved a Measure S Phase II design and construction administration contract for Lionakis Architects, to provide these design services for Orange HS, to prepare Option 2 design in the amount of \$1,450,000;
 - Demolition of existing 100/200 building (includes 10 classrooms and current Student Services suites).
 - o Construction of a new 15-classroombuilding with student services suite.
- The Board of Education approved a Measure S Phase II design and construction administration contract for Cannon Design Architects, to provide these design services for Canyon HS, to prepare Option 2 design in the amount of \$620,000;
 - Full Modernization and utility/security/technology/restroom upgrades to building 200 (existing science building).

- As of 7/31/19, at El Modena HS Science Center, processing Angeles Contractor payment applications # 2 (June) reflecting 6% paid overall completion.





 - CD # 20 for a not-to-exceed (NTE) price of \$16,000 to provide PA system connects at bldgs. 700 & 800 (part of Allowance # 2).




