As you will see next week, we now have a school building that has nearly doubled in size, with increased parking and thoughtfully planned landscaping that enhances the overall aesthetic of our campus. New spaces inside will accommodate students for arrival and dismissal, lunch, assemblies, performances, and more. You also won't be able to miss our awesome new playground out front! Complete with swings, bench seating, and a well-appointed sun shade, we know this new recreation space will be well-loved and utilized by our students.

### Orientation

Earlier this summer, we invited all Pre-K, Kindergarten, and Grades 1-3 new students and their families to school on Tuesday, September 3 for the following orientations:

9:00 to 10:00 a.m.	Pre-K Orientation, ALL Pre-K students and parents (no siblings, please)
9:00 to 10:00 a.m.	New Student Orientation, new students in grades 1-3 only
9:00 to 11:00 a.m.	New Parent Coffee, parents of new students in grades 1-3
10:00 to 11:00 a.m.	Kindergarten Orientation, ALL K students and parents (no siblings, please)
10:00 to 11:00 a.m.	World Language Orientation, new students only, grades 1-3

During their orientation, students will have the opportunity to meet their teachers and some classmates. Students are welcome to come to orientation in comfortable, casual clothing; they do not need to be in our Primary School Code of Attire though they are welcome to do so if desired.

### First Day of School

Our first day of school is **Wednesday, September 4!** This will be a full school day beginning at 8:00 a.m. and concluding at 2:20 p.m. That morning, faculty, staff, and administrators will be available to greet students and help them find their classrooms. We know that the first day of a new school year

is exciting for all; therefore, you are welcome to walk your children into the building and to their classrooms on the first day of school if you wish. If you do, please be sure to arrive early enough to park on neighboring streets with consideration for our neighbors and in accordance with all posted parking signs.

In addition to the security personnel and administrators who will be out on carline each morning next Wednesday, one of the Pre-K teachers will meet and greet all Pre-K students at morning drop-off during the first few weeks of school to help students transition into the building. At dismissal, all Pre-K students will be similarly escorted to their buses and cars by supervising faculty and staff.

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We are ready to go and can't wait to see you. Thank you for your commitment to this community – for your support of and investment in the work we do and the relationships we seek to build, and for placing your trust in us to encourage and care for your children every day. I look forward to seeing you next week as well as when we come together for Back to School Night on Thursday, September 26 at 6:00 p.m. Please mark your calendar!

As we head into the new school year, I feel grateful and honored to work with such a dedicated, purposeful team as the one we have at the Primary School. We wish you a wonderful last weekend of summer and look forward to welcoming you all back to Brookside on September 4.
