About the School Building Project

This intra-district elementary International Baccalaureate magnet school serve students in grades PreK-5. The centrally located learning commons, equipped with flexible furnishings & adaptable technological infrastructure, allows for multiple zones of simultaneous learning. The building is designed to meet the sustainability goals established by the Educational Specifications and to achieve a gold-level LEED rating from US Green Building Council.

- The campus OPENED to students on August 29, 2019.
 - Special Thanks to William Marr, John Vallerie, Peter Robinson, William Schwartz, Robert Natale and the rest of the town safety & building inspectors for their efforts to ensure the building opened safely and on time for the first day of the new school year.

Work anticipated for the coming weeks:

- Playground installation will be ongoing thru September
- Sod will be placed late September.
- Landscaping and fencing are being installed and will continue as per the approved plan.
 - Plantings will continue through the fall due to the respective planting seasons
- Ballfield reconstruction will be completed in the fall as part of Phase 3 of the approved plan.

The project has received its 5th reimbursement from the state, \$1,196,911, totaling \$16,935,078 to date.

A 6th reimbursement has been submitted in the amount of \$767,281, due in September.
