How to Earn Free Tickets to the May Luncheon and Other Awards

- (1) Have all 2019-2020 PTA Officers entered into the Texas Two Step and supply the MISD Council of PTAs a board roster by Oct. 31st.
- (2) The PTA/PTSAs must have a representative in attendance at 4 out of the 6 MISD Council of PTAs meetings.
- (3) PTA/PTSA must be in good standing with Texas PTA by January 30th. (Example: 20 members turned into state, 990s filed by Aug. 30th, Sales Tax filed by Jan. 20th, Bylaws & Standing rules updated in the last 3 years).
- (4) Provide a minimum of 3 volunteers for the MISD Clothes Closet on the PTA/PTSA's designated day or contact the Clothes Closet Chairman to schedule volunteers on one of the designated evening events.
- (5) Organize a collection of World Wear items or items from the school's Lost and Found. These items will need to be donated to the Clothes Closet by the fall deadline of December or the spring deadline of April.
- (6) Organize an underwear, sock, white t-shirt, or school supply drive for the Clothes Closet between the months of July- April. (Minimum # of items to qualify: 50 pairs of underwear or socks, 25 t-shirts, 100 items of school supplies)
- (7) From February 1st – April 27th, we will do a community drive for the MISD Clothes Closet and The Caring Place. Listed below is a list of the hygiene items each school is responsible for:
 - (a) All Elementary Schools: Collection of Deodorant (Minimum of 50 items)
 - (b) All Intermediate & Middle Schools: Collection of Shampoo & Conditioner (Minimum of 100 – 4 ounce items or 400 – 1 ounce items)
 - (c) All High Schools: Collection of Soap or Body Wash (Minimum of 50 – 4 ounces or larger or 100 less than 4 ounces)

All items collected, and lunch reservations with payment due on the following dates:

DEADLINE to earn TWO FREE TICKETS is May 4th

DEADLINE for TABLE DECORATIONS and RESERVED SEATING is May 8th

AWARDS:

- (1) The PTA/PTSAs who meet all 7 MISD Council of PTAs requirements will receive two free food tickets to the May Luncheon, reserved seats and a table decorated in school colors.
- (2) The top High School, Middle School, Intermediate School, and Elementary School PTAs who bring in the most items from the Community Drive will be presented with a trophy/plaque.
- (3) The High School, Middle School, Intermediate School, and Elementary School PTAs who donate the most items of socks/underwear/white T-shirts, or school supplies will be presented with a Special Recognition award.
