

Association of Chinese Americans Scholarship- For the class of 2020, they offer a total of seventeen scholarships to students, who reside in Michigan, and are interested in serving the Chinese American community, or are Chinese American, or are of Chinese ancestry. Most of the scholarships require the student to have a minimum of 3.5 GPA or better on a scale of 4.0 or equivalent and satisfactory test scores (ACT/SAT/PSAT). Apply on-line.

Horatio Alger Association- The scholarship program provides financial assistance to students throughout the nation who have significant financial need and have exhibited integrity and perseverance in overcoming personal adversity. Eligibility criteria include: high school graduation in spring/summer, demonstrated critical financial need (\$55,000 or lower adjusted gross family income), and United States citizenship. OPPU Achievers Scholarship- OppU Schievers Scholarship \$2,500 seniors with a minimum GPA of 3.0/4.0 to apply, students submit a short essay online.

The Officer Collin Rose Memorial Foundation Scholarship- Award \$1,000- The Officer Rose Memorial Foundation Scholarship honors the memory of fallen Wayne State University Police Officer Collin Rose. He was murdered while on a street investigation in Detroit in November 2016. He was pursuing a master's degree from the university at the time of his death. This scholarship may be renewed once for the following academic year. Student must request renewal by April 1 the academic year of the initial award and show proof of continued enrollment in one of the eligible fields of study while maintaining passing grades. Applicant shall be majoring in mediation, dispute resolution, criminal justice, law enforcement, firefighting or paramedic services. For
