Dear Sophomore Parents,

At your son's orientation on August 27, he signed up for his sophomore retreat at the Romero Center in Camden, NJ. We had sent the retreat dates home and they were posted on our website to facilitate this process, in an attempt to better avoid conflicts with his personal and co-curricular activities, and to limit changes to the rosters once completed. I took all of these requests into account as I formed the rosters included with this letter. However, in a number of circumstances, I needed to give a student one of his alternate choices in order to balance the retreats. I tried my best to take school-related co-curricular activities into account when making these decisions. I hope your son will be satisfied with his assignment.

In our *Student Handbook*, we note that:

As a "school for the Lord's service" (RB Prologue v. 45) that believes "that God invites us into a deeper relationship with Him," we seek to foster the spiritual development of our students and help them to grow in faith and love. One of the chief means of this effort is our school retreats... These retreats and "days of recollection" flow from the core beliefs of the school, are an expression of the school's mission, and serve to form Delbarton students in the values of the school...

Since we at Delbarton believe that this retreat experience is such an important part of your son's spiritual development, we do ask that you make every effort to adjust your personal schedules to accommodate it and keep attempts to change his retreat to cases of absolute necessity. If there is a serious conflict with the retreat on which your son has been placed, your son is to seek out a classmate from another retreat with whom he can "trade" retreats. This way the numbers on the retreats will remain relatively constant. Kindly contact me as soon as a trade has been made so I can adjust my records (mwhite@delbarton.org). If your son has a pressing reason to change his retreat, and has tried his best to make a trade but been unsuccessful, please do not hesitate to call me directly at ext. 2345 (I am the coordinator of the Sophomore Retreats, so please do not reach out to Dr. Hajduk). I'm sure we will be able to work out a solution. Please understand that, due to planning concerns, last minute changes cannot be made, except in cases of emergency. As your son's retreat approaches, you will receive more retreat-specific information by way of the weekly "News from Delbarton" email.

This Romero Center retreat, is heralded by both students and faculty as "eye opening" and "transformative." It will be held at the St. Oscar Romero Center in Camden, NJ and will run from Wednesday after school (3pm) through Friday after school (4pm). It is a version of the Romero Center's "Urban Experience" that forms students in Catholic Social Teaching and offers various community service opportunities! The retreat program in general has been a tradition here at Delbarton for over three decades. We so value these experiences that we ask our teachers to be flexible with students who will be attending a retreat (in fact, there are specific retreat homework policy guidelines for teachers and students). Also, since the retreat is mandatory for sophomores and the students are not permitted to leave for any portion of it, our Director of Athletics and coaches understand that some students may have to miss games or practices in order to attend. Although it may entail some sacrifices, we believe your son will come to value his retreat experience greatly! Together, you and I can encourage your son as he prepares to share in a worthwhile and fun weekend.

Again, please be in touch if you foresee any conflicts, or would like to learn more about the weekend. Thank you for your support of the spiritual mission of our school.
