

## What is YES Prep?

YES Prep Public Schools is a public charter school system with 18 campuses across Houston. We serve grades 6-12 and focus on preparing students for success in college. We provide services that traditional public schools offer, including special education, English Language Learner support, athletics, a free/reduced lunch program, and free transportation. We also participate in the same state testing, including STAAR and End of Course exams. It is free to attend YES Prep and, we are an open-enrollment school system which means that there are no application requirements to attend one of our schools.

## What is a charter school?

Charter schools are public schools. The state gives charter schools more freedom when it comes to staffing, curriculum, instructional approach, and such basics as the length of the school day or year. Because charter schools are public schools, the state also holds YES Prep accountable to meeting the same high financial and academic standards as traditional public schools. We meet these standards without compromising the quality of education our students receive on a daily basis.

## How do I apply?

As a free and open-enrollment school system, YES Prep has an application process for those interested in attending our schools. Given that there are more applicants than available seats, we are required by law to admit students using a lottery process which selects applicants at random. The lottery application period opens every year from November to early February and applicants are asked to provide basic information. It is important to note that we provide free transportation at all of our campuses to students who reside within the school's priority zone. 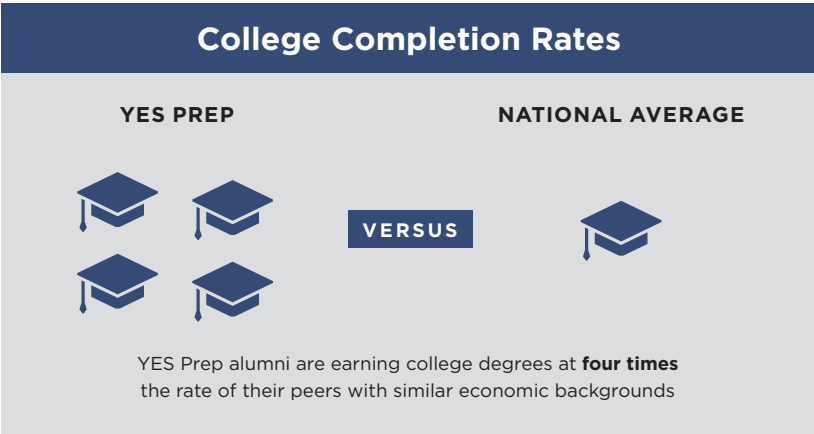
## Why Attend YES Prep?

### Teacher Excellence

We know that excellent teachers make an incredible difference in our students’ success, so we hire teachers who are passionate and represent a diversity of backgrounds. We also provide teacher training, development, and assign a teacher-coach so that our teachers are well-supported in the classroom.

### College-Preparatory Education

Everything we do is designed to support our mission that every student will graduate from college prepared to lead. In middle school, students receive extra time in math and reading. In high school, students take Advanced Placement classes that give them the opportunity to earn college credits.



### College Counseling

We guide students and their families through the process of choosing and applying to colleges that are a good match for them. We also help families understand and apply for financial aid, seek scholarships, and identify other ways to pay for college. In high school, students participate in seminar classes to help them develop the skills necessary for college such as time management and study skills.

### Class Trips & Summer Opportunities

Students participate in class trips to visit colleges and universities. Internships, camps, and other summer programs are also important ways for our students to gain the experiences that make them college and career ready. Campuses support our students in participating in summer experiences like internships or service trips to another country.

### School Day & Extracurricular Activities

While all of our campuses focus on preparing students for college, each campus provides a unique experience. Most campuses have a longer school day, 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. on average, and students have the opportunity to participate in sports and clubs, including Student Council, National Honors Society, chess, and much more.
