
NEW BEFORE/AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS-

•Strings-Violin for 1st & 2nd Graders- The Endeavour Strings Club will be open to 1st and 2nd graders. Participants learn to play the violin with proper techniques, correct position, sound intonation, and rhythm. Over the course of the year, students will play "Twinkle. Twinkle. Little Star" from Suzuki Violin Book 1 in every rhythmic variation. It is expected that one parent consistently attend the class and help his/her child practice at home. 



The PTA does not make any money from Box Tops. It all goes directly to the school!


HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR BOX TOPS:



- Cut Box Top clips from participating product packages. *IMPORTANT - Please be sure to have the expiration date and the product code visible or they can not be accepted. (see image)
- Check to be sure the Box Tops haven't passed their expiration date.
- 3. Tape, staple, or glue Box Tops to a collection sheet.
- Turn completed sheet into your teacher to help your class earn prizes!!

Also, please download the BOX TOPS APP on your phones!! The box top program is changing and having the box top app on your phone is going to be required in order to redeem them!

The OLD Box Tops Clips



Traditional Box Tops clips are being phased out of production, but may continue to be found on many products throughout the store. You can still clip and send them to school

Every valid Box Tops dip is worth 10¢ for your school. Make sure each one has a dearly visible product acronym and expiration date.

The NEW Box Tops Labels



Eventually the Box Tops program will become digital-only. Participating brands are starting to change their packaging from a traditional Box Tops clip to the new Box Top label.

If you see this label, use the new Box Tops app to scan your receipt. Box Tops are still worth 10¢ each for your school. The app will find participating products purchased at any store and instantly add cash to your school's earnings online.

BOX TOPS FOR EDUCATION

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR BOX TOPS:

1. Cut on the dotted line to cut out Box Tops clips from participating product packages.

- 2. IMPORTANT: Each Box Tops clip must have a visible product acronym and expiration date so please do not rip these off or BTFE will not accept them.
- 3. Check the expiration dates and please do not send expired clips as they will not be accepted.
- 4. Tape, staple or glue Box Tops to a collection sheet.
- a. To obtain collection sheets: ask your teacher for additional sheets or print them from the school website or the Box Top website.
- 5. Bonus Credits accepted please submit them separately in a baggie (staple baggie to the sheet).
- 6. Remember to write your student's name, teacher's name and grade on the sheet and/or baggie.
- 7. Turn Box Tops in to your classroom into the laminated folder/envelope!
- 8. Continue to collect and submit Box Tops throughout the year invite your friends and family to collect box tops for you!


