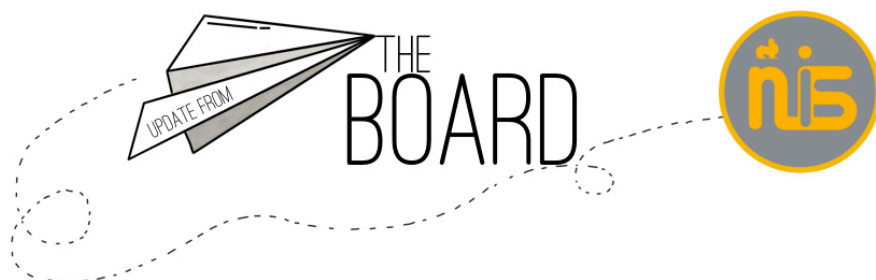

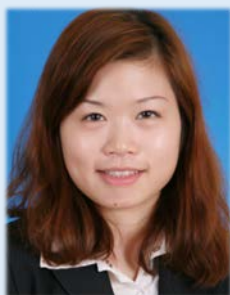

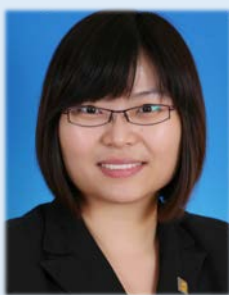

Swimmers who wish to be part of this year's Musical Production (Little Shop of Horrors), should sign up for the audition on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> August to avoid a clash.

For the Mini-Squad, students age 8 and under will be invited to the first training session, Friday August 30<sup>th</sup>. Requirement for this team is that they are able to swim a length across the big pool.

Training opportunities are available in the pool every afternoon for swim squad members or those who want to be one.

A workout will be written on a white board and self-motivated students may follow these to get back in shape for the swim season / time trials.

The student who shows the most **respect, commitment and teamwork** will be rewarded (On Wednesday 21.8.) with my 'Master's World Championship Swimming Cap'

#### Prerequisites for ASA Lifeguarding Course:

Candidates must:

1. Be at least 15 years old on or before the final scheduled session of the course.
2. Swim 300 yards, continuously demonstrating breath control and rhythmic breathing. Candidates may swim using the front crawl, breaststroke or a combination of both, but swimming on the back or side is not allowed. Swim goggles may be used.
3. Tread water for 2 minutes, using only the legs. Candidates should place their hands under the armpits.
4. Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds: Starting in the water, swim 20 meters. Swim goggles are not allowed. Surface dive, feet-first or head-first, to a depth of 7 to 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object. Return to the surface and swim 20 yards on the back to return to the starting point with both hands holding the object and keeping the face at or near the surface so they are able to get a breath.  
Exit the water without using a ladder or steps.

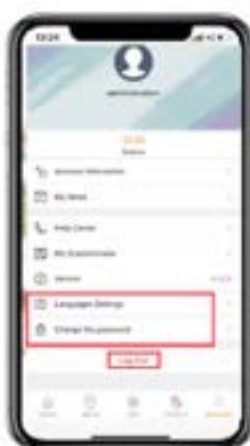
