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Dear Elmbrook Families,

It is important to ensure that every student in our district is prepared for each step along their educational journey. One way to determine student preparedness is through assessment. In accordance to the state mandated assessment schedule, the School District of Elmbrook administered the ACT Aspire assessment to all students in grades nine and ten this past spring.

Included with this letter, you will find your child’s Individual Student Report (ISR). The ISR shows your child’s performance on the spring 2019 ACT Aspire assessment. The ACT Aspire is a standardized test designed to evaluate and report on student learning and college and career readiness. The ACT Aspire Early High School assessment measures what students have learned in the areas of English, Reading, Math, Science, and Writing. The scores from this assessment predict how a student will perform on the ACT assessment when they reach grade 11.

The ISR includes subject and composite test scores, ACT Readiness Level, Score Range, National Percentile Rank, and Predicted ACT Score. It also includes Supplemental Scores including English Language Arts (ELA) and STEM (Science and Math), Progress with Text Complexity, and Progress Toward Career Readiness.
