The CIT meeting started at 4:00 and ended at 5:25 PM. Members in attendance were Mr. de la Riva, Ms. Wilson, Mr. Bergstrom, Ms. Cooper, Ms. King, Ms. Pearson, Ms. Tatum, and Ms. Tilotta.

Mr. de la Riva reintroduced the CIP, which was sent to the entire team in June to review. During the CIT meeting the team reviewed the CIP and made minor modifications. The CIT team voted and approved the CIP for the 2019-2020 school year.

CIT member discussed and requested for the KickBoard store to have more availability and options for the students, as this seems to have a positive impact on student achievement—the CIT agreed and approved.

Mr. de la Riva discussed the SEL weekly meetings, which is a goal listed in the CIP. CIT member asked how this impact on our campus was going to carry over to the HS level to continue supporting our students, once they leave MS. Mr. de la Riva indicated he would speak with the HS principals and get feedback regarding their pathways, in order to align our programs so that every student is part of an extracurricular activity through MS and through HS. Mr. de la Riva revisited the mission/vision and indicated we will continue to align our resources/budget to the mission/vision, which includes providing opportunities for students to access and be ready for T-2-4.

Mr. de la Riva shared the Title 1 budget for the coming school year. Mr. de la Riva proposed an opportunity to provide direct instructional support for our SS team, which would entail a \$22,000 amendment to pay the \$22,000 contract with TRICE. The CIT discussed and agreed to the amendment.

The CIT had a question about Title 1 funds spent on employees. Mr. de la Riva provided a list of staff members paid out of Title 1, via email.

CIT member requested Mr. de la Riva continue to communicate via email and call-out regarding school safety, early dismissal, school start times, backpacks, and positive reports to the community. Mr. de la Riva will follow up on these items.
