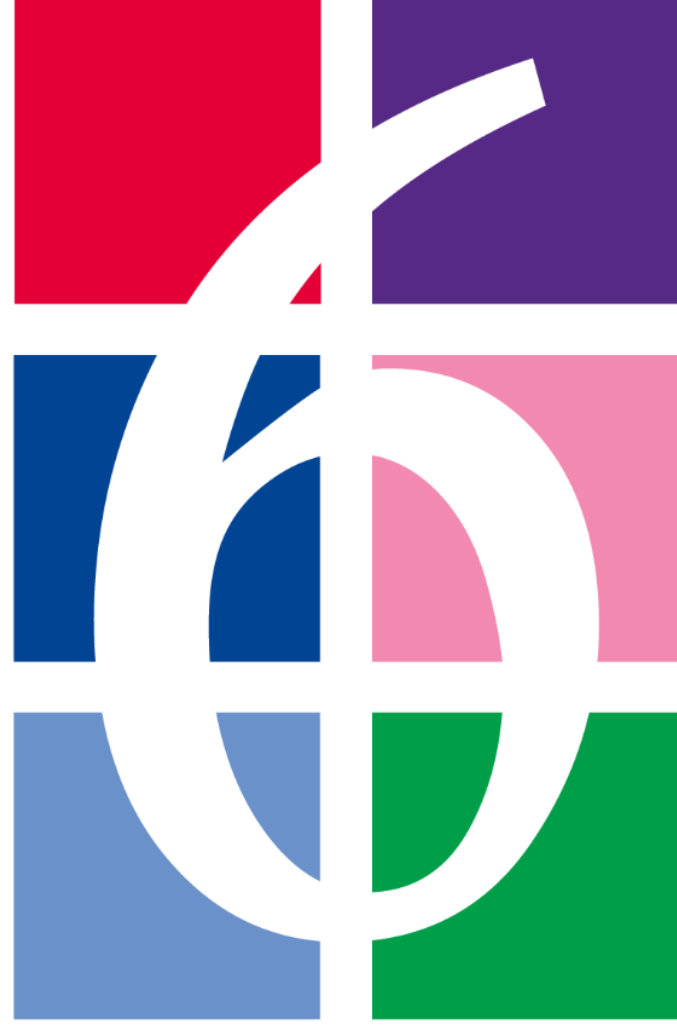
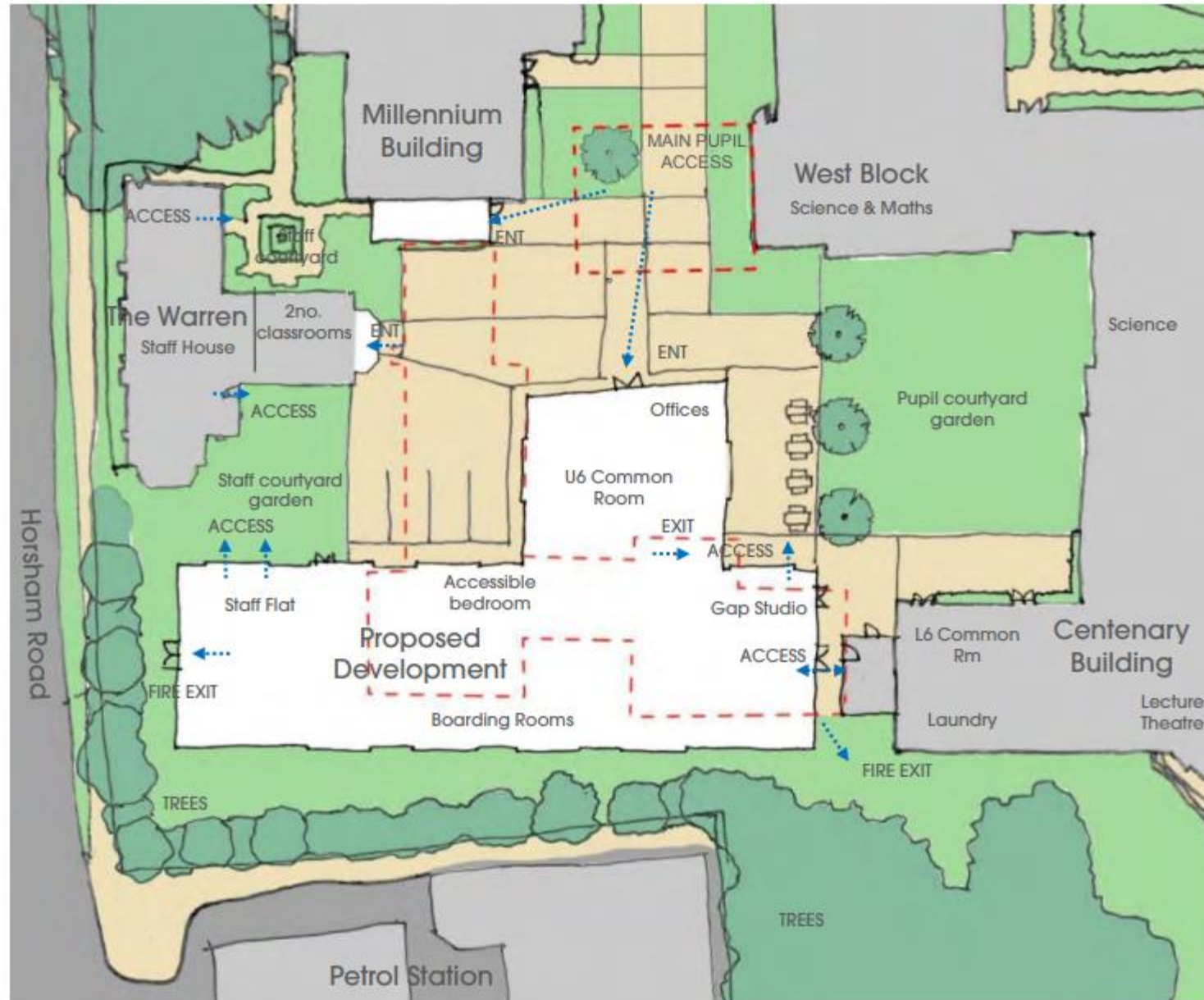

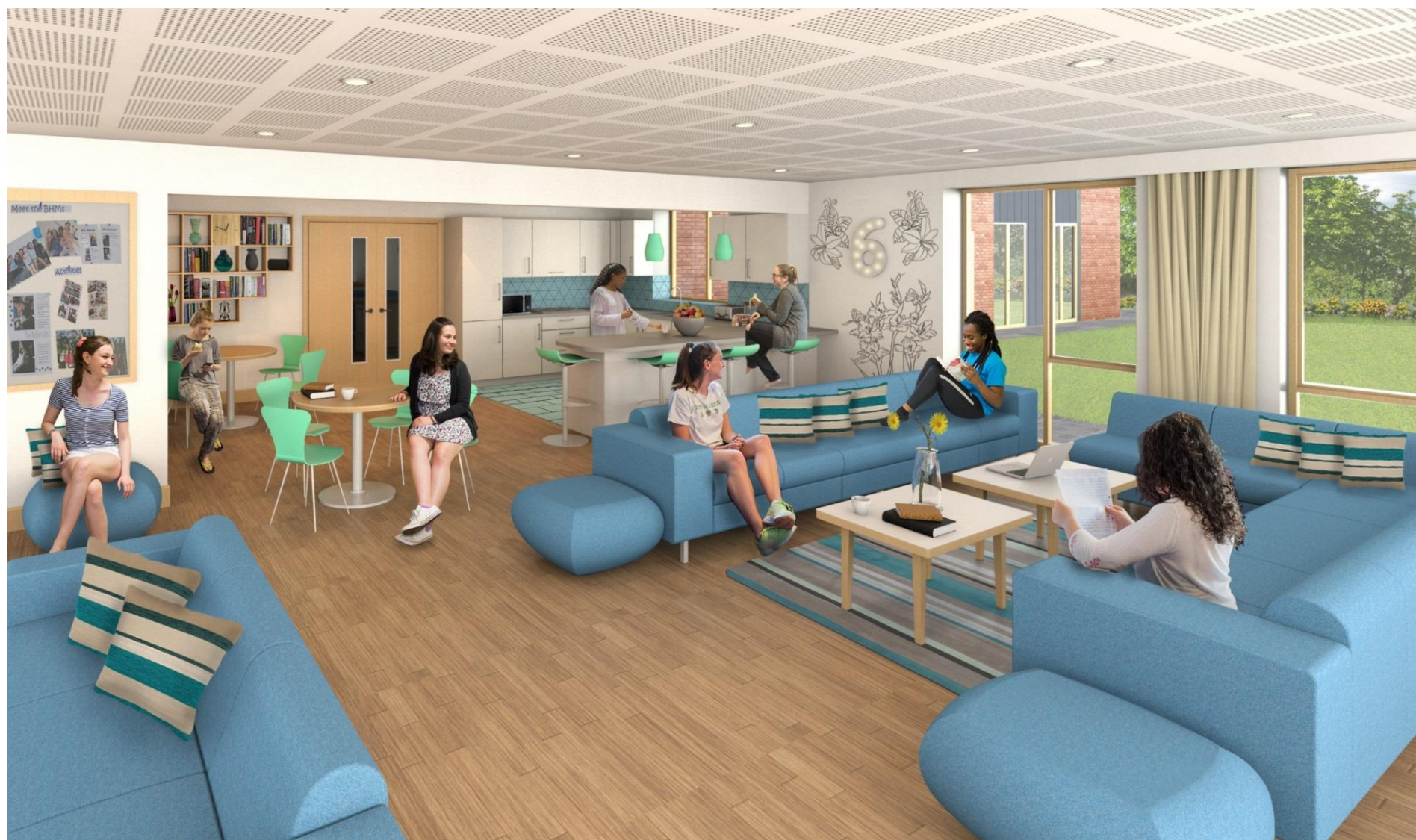




Circulation routes and Courtyard zoning

Born in the South Side of Chicago, Michelle Obama's mother and father instilled in their daughter a heartfelt commitment to family, hard work and education. Michelle earned a bachelor's degree from Princeton University and a doctoral degree from Harvard Law School. In 1988, she returned to Chicago to join the firm of Sidley Austin. It was there that she met Barack Obama whom she married in 1992.

As first lady, Mrs. Obama initiated the *Let's Move* programme with the aim of reducing childhood obesity. Each year local schoolchildren helped plant and harvest the garden she started on the White House South Lawn. Its vegetables and fruits were served at the White House and donated to soup kitchens and food banks.

During the Obama's second term Michelle spearheaded the *Reach Higher Initiative*, encouraging young people to continue their education past high-school. Worldwide, she championed the education of girls and women. She also focused her energies on what she calls her most important role – Mom-in-Chief to her daughters!
