**Ad Hoc Committee on Future Enrollment  
To Advise the Princeton Board of Education and Superintendent**

The Ad Hoc Committee on Future Enrollment is charged with advising the Board of Education and Superintendent by:

- i) Reviewing the assumptions and model utilized by the Princeton Public Schools' demographer and reviewing results of an updated demographic study;
- ii) Considering any relevant factors reflected in such study;
- iii) Preparing a written narrative addressing District enrollment based on updated demographic study and committee consideration of other relevant factors, addressing future enrollment levels, distribution of any increase/decrease across neighborhoods and student attributes, to the extent reasonably estimable; and
- iv) Facilitating communication and understanding of reasonable District enrollment projections through public forum(s) and presentations to the Board and municipal Planning Board.

Assumptions shall include, but not be limited to:

Princeton University expansion plans

Princeton Theological Seminary plans to relocate students to Mercer Campus

Institute for Advanced Study new construction

Cranbury demographic projections, including known development plans

Municipal affordable housing settlement

Other reasonably anticipated/pending/approved municipal  
development applications/building permits
