Each year, two Campbell Scholars will be awarded 100% tuition for four years. All finalists not selected as Campbell Scholars are awarded the Sally and Glenn Ramsdell Scholarship (a one-time \$5,000 award), and up to 100% of any additional demonstrated financial need. Take a moment to review the following requirements, deadlines, and important information about the Campbell Scholarship. If you have any questions, please contact the Office of Admission at (210) 483-9234 or admission@smhall.org.

Once the following requirements are fulfilled, your Campbell Scholarship Application will be complete:

- Student must be entering Form 9 (9th grade) in the fall of 2020.
- Student must have a minimum GPA of 4.0 for the first quarter of 8th grade.
 - Only core academic course grades will be considered (English, math, science, and social studies). Please refer to the GPA scale on page three to determine if your GPA qualifies.
- Student must complete a day visit and interview at Saint Mary's Hall.
- Parents must complete a parent meeting with the Head of Admission and Enrollment Management.
- Student must take the Independent School Entrance Examination (ISEE).
- Submit the following documents to the Office of Admission *no later than 4pm on Friday, November 15, 2019*:
 - Online Application for Admission with student essay and questionnaire. Application is at www.smhall.org under Admission and then Application Process. **Be sure to check the Campbell Scholarship box within the application!**
 - English Teacher Recommendation form
 - Math Teacher Recommendation form
 - Extracurricular Recommendation form
 - Administrator's Recommendation Form
 - Official school transcripts for 6th–7th grade and the most recent 8th grade report card
- Please note that it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure all items are received by the deadline, including teacher recommendation forms.
- **Because the Campbell Scholarship is competitive, absolutely no exceptions can be made for late applications or supporting documents/recommendation forms.**

Campbell Scholarship Calendar

- **Friday, November 15, 2019.** The entire application packet (see above) must be received by the Office of Admission no later than 4pm.
- **Saturday, November 30, 2019.** Deadline to register for the ISEE without a late fee.
- **Wednesday, December 4, 2019.** Deadline for parent meeting and applicant's day visit and interview
- **Saturday, December 7, 2019.** ISEE testing at Saint Mary's Hall
 - Please plan to check in at the Marrs and Verna McLean Library by 7:30 am.
 - Breakfast will be provided for parents and students in the Peggy Pitman Mays Dining Hall.
 - **Unfortunately, students who arrive after 8:00 am will not be allowed to test and will no longer be considered for the Campbell Scholarship.**
- **Friday, December 20, 2019.** Campbell Scholarship finalists and Form 9 applicants will be selected and notified before or during the semester break.
- **Saturday, January 25, 2020.** Campbell Scholarship finalists will be interviewed by the Selection Committee, and winners will be announced the following week.

Important information about Campbell Scholarship requirements:

- **Day Visit.** As part of the application process, students are required to spend time on campus visiting classes. *This requirement must be fulfilled by Wednesday, December 4, 2019.* Attendance at one of the Saint Mary's Hall preview events may qualify as the day visit. Please confirm this with the Office of Admission. Once an application has been submitted, the Office of Admission will contact you to schedule a day visit. Visits will begin on Wednesday, September 18, 2019.
- **Student Interview and Parent Meeting.** The student interview and parent meeting are typically completed during the student's day visit. However, if the student attends an open house in lieu of a day visit, the Office of Admission will contact you to schedule these appointments on a separate day.
- **Independent School Entrance Examination (ISEE).** **Saturday, December 7, 2019,** is the last date to take the ISEE and qualify for the Campbell Scholarship. This date will not be found in the ISEE guide or listed online, as it is a closed test date available only to Campbell applicants. The test will be administered on the Saint Mary's Hall campus.
 - **ISEE Registration Information.** The Saint Mary's Hall school code is 446220.
 - **Sunday, December 1, 2019,** is the *last day* to register online for the ISEE to be held on **Saturday, December 7** at Saint Mary's Hall.
 - You may register online at www.iseetest.org. Online registration for this testing date requires an event code: **GE5X9NLT**.

- **ISEE Registration Information, continued:**
 - The registration cost is \$125, with an additional \$25 charge if registering by phone. Late registration is available until December 1 for a cost of \$155. Walk-in registration may be available if spaces remain. It costs \$185 and can only be arranged by contacting the Office of Admission.
- **Please note: the ISEE may be taken at another test site before December 7, but it must be completed by this date.** The ISEE may be taken up to three times during a 12-month cycle. Visit www.iseetest.org for information on testing windows and to view preparation materials, including a full-length practice test.
 - If taken at another test site, please be sure to specify Saint Mary's Hall as one of the schools to receive your scores (school code 446220).

Qualifying as a Campbell Scholarship Finalist:

- To qualify as a Campbell Scholarship finalist, students must achieve an average in the 90th percentile or above for the four sections of the ISEE, with no section score below the 80th percentile.
- **Due to the competitive nature of the scholarship, ISEE averages cannot be rounded up and no exceptions will be made for averages below the 90th percentile.**
- Students must maintain a GPA of 4.0 or higher in academic core classes (English, math, science, and social studies) for the semester. Semester grades will be requested in January before scheduling the final interview with the Campbell Selection Committee.
