Any violation of these requirements is unethical and can result in disciplinary action up to and including suspension from school and/or appropriate legal action.

Since all files are on a public network and on equipment provided by the school district, these files are subject to examination and review at any time and no right of privacy exists.

Although Iredell-Statesville Schools provides Internet access that is filtered and supervised, there are text and graphic files available on the Internet which are inappropriate for minors. The student is ultimately responsible for his/her actions and the school system will not be held responsible for materials which the student might access.

The activities that are not permitted include, but are not limited to the following:

- Cyberbullying
- Sending or displaying offensive communication or pictures
- Using obscene language
- Harassing, insulting, or attacking others
- Violating copyright laws, including failure to cite online sources
- Giving personal information such as complete name, phone number, address, or identifiable photo, without consent from teacher and parent/guardian
- Trespassing in the folders, work, or files of others
- Disabling or circumventing filtering/security software
- Using logins, user names, and/or passwords of other users
- Employing the network/Internet for commercial purposes, financial gain, fraud, or illegal activities
- Damaging or modifying computers, computer systems, or computer networks
- Use of personal equipment on the district network

MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ONLY

Laptops are issued to students as an educational tool and should be used in that capacity. The cost for replacing and/or repairing the laptop due to damage, negligence, or theft that occur while the laptop is assigned to the student may be the sole responsibility of the undersigned parent/guardian. School/district staff will investigate all damage claims or incidents.

STUDENT TECHNOLOGY CHARGES - Device/Cords/Damages

In addition to the Technology Fees, students (and parents) are responsible for charges incurred due to lost cords, stolen or lost devices, and machine damages and repair costs. In an effort to ensure a balance between compliance, fairness, and awareness of student/parent hardship, Iredell-Statesville Schools provides the following guidance for schools in working with students and parents regarding technology charges:

Screen	Damaged (to include hinge damage)	\$159 (replacement)

Keyboard	Missing/Replacement Key - \$10 per key Missing Cone - (foam piece under keys) \$149	\$10 - \$159
Case Damage	Top Case - \$159.00 Bottom Case - \$69.00 Clamshell/LCD Display/Screen Case	\$69 - \$449

The annual Technology Usage Fee is not insurance and will NOT lower or cover any repair costs such as:

- Loss or stolen computers or accessory
- Intentional damage to the computer or accessory
- Damage to the computer that is caused by gross negligence

Devices that are lost or stolen while off-campus must be reported to law enforcement, a police report must be completed and submitted to the school, and the school principal notified within 1 business day. The principal is to be notified immediately if the laptop is lost or stolen while on-campus.
