Standing committees report

- A. SNAP- no changes
- B. Reading Improvement- Acadience (DIBELS) testing this week for beginning of the year benchmark
- C. Technology Advancement- All technology monies spent as planned 5/6 grade students now 1:1,

3/4 /2/1 grade student now 1:2

- D. Professional Development- All teachers attended GoMath training in August. Sept. 23 new SEED (science) standards training for all teachers.
- E. Land trust- All monies spent according to SIP plan

SIP goals reviewed

- A. Reading- increase the number of students in grades 1 through 3 who make typical or above growth as measured in the Acadience middle-of-year benchmark from 69% to 71%
- B. Math- increase the number of students scoring proficient in the RISE from 58% to 60%
- C. Project Lead the Way- all students will complete on module of instruction k-4 coding, 5-6 robotics

CUBS explained- school-wide behavior expectations

New school updates- construction still scheduled to complete in March 2020- move in anticipated in April 2020- resulting parking loss addressed with ideas such as “walking or biking “ pools instead of carpools, alternative drop-off and pick-up locations
